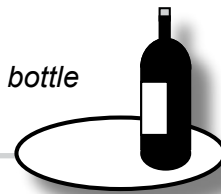

<b>Groth Cabernet, Napa Valley, CA</b> Concentrated and dense, with rich black cherry and blackberry fruit that's intense and full-blown. Muscular, yet displays deft balance. Ends with a compact, layered finish.	2007	\$195
<b>Kathryn Hall Napa Valley Cabernet, CA</b> Outstanding for its purity and the incredibly fine tannins, not to mention the compelling flavors: black and red cherries, currants, cola and mushrooms.	2006	96
<b>Argiano, Brunello di Montalcino, Italy</b> The bouquet offers plum, cherry and tobacco. Opens with lovely fruit blanced with acidity and tannins. Excellent structure with a finish that won't quit.	2006	89
<b>D'Arenberg Dead Arm Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Australia</b> This fresh, open-textured Shiraz is generous with its currant and plum fruit, mingling harmoniously with spicy notes on the complex finish.	2008	79
<b>The Prisoner, Napa Valley Red Wine, CA</b> A blend of Zinfandel, Cabernet, Syrah, Petite Sirah, Chardboro and Grenache. Rich and ripe, showing aromas of black cherry, boysenberry and smoky pepper.	2011	69
<b>Flowers Pinot Noir, Sonoma Coast, CA</b> One of the most graceful pinot noirs in the world. A brisk forestry scent, bright red fruit in the middle and hints of black tea, pink grapefruit and cranberry all contribute to the complexity.	2009	65
<b>Rombauer Chardonnay, Carneros, CA</b> Full, rich and buttery, balanced with creamy toasted vanilla overtones.	2011	59
<b>Ken Wright Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, OR</b> Light and satiny, with modest tannins around a delicate core of cherry, raspberry and coffee flavors, fleshing out more on the long finish.	2010	49
<b>Louis Michel, Chablis Montmains, France</b> Juicy and supple, with ripe, fruit-driven aromas of pineapple and grapefruit plus a hint of mint. Distinctly fruity on the front half, then shows solid mineral grip on the classically dry back end.	2011	54
<b>Craggy Range Te Muna Rd Sauvignon Blanc, NZ</b> Zesty citrus, stonefruit, herb and floral flavours fill the mouth, a fine chalky mineral texture tightens and focuses the finish.	2010	42
<b>Chateau Montelena Chardonnay, Napa Valley, CA</b> Intense aromas of lemon honey and spicy pie crust. Nectarine, peach and citrus shine through on the palette with firm acidity and an excellent mouthfeel.	2010	62
